DEPARTMENT OF PATHOLOGICAL ANATOMY. Founded in 1957. From 1957 to 1965, the department was headed by Associate Professor P.D. Tulyaganov. In 1965-1995, the department was headed by Professor N.G. Alexandrov. Under the leadership of N.G. Aleksandrov, 6 doctors of sciences and 31 candidates of medical sciences were trained. From 1995 to 2001, the department was headed by Associate Professor A.N. Don, from 2001 to 2008 the department was headed by Professor A.S. Churikova, from 2008 to 2014 associate professor Sh.Kh. Hamrakulov. Since 2014, the head is Associate Professor A.R. Mamataliev.

TULYAGANOV FOZIL (1924-2001)



In 1952 he graduated from the Tashkent State Medical Institute. He headed the Department of Pathological Anatomy of the ASMI from 1962-1965, In 1966-1968. Department of Pathological Anatomy of the Tashkent Medical Institute. From 1971 to 1976, he headed the Department of Forensic Medicine. He is the author of 96 scientific articles, 2 textbooks and 2 teaching aids on the pathology of the digestive system, endemic goiter and the cardiovascular system. Under his leadership, 1 doctor of medical sciences and 11 candidates of medical sciences were trained.

ALEXANDROV NIKOLAY (1932-1995).



In 1957. - Associate Professor of the Department of Forensic Medicine, from 1965-1955 - Head of the Department Pathological anatomy, professor NG Aleksandrov studied the venous pathology of endemic goiter in the Fergana Valley and developed a complex problem of autoimmune processes in the development of atherosclerosis. 5 doctoral and 31 candidate dissertations were defended under his supervision.



CHURIKOVA ALEXANDRA - Graduated from ASMI in 1963. Professor Churikova A.S. Under her leadership, 1 candidate and 1 doctoral dissertations were defended, more than 12 clinical residents were trained. In her work, she has published over 400 scientific articles and over 60 textbooks. She is the author of over 60 improvement proposals.



DON ANDREI 1995-1999 Head of the Department of Pathological Anatomy, Associate Professor.

Under his guidance, the anti-atherosclerotic effects of triterpene saponins were studied. Author of over 200 scientific articles and abstracts, 2 inventions, 20 rationalization proposals and 2

teaching aids, more than 40 teaching aids. During his work at the department, along with scientific

research work, he paid serious attention to the educational process and its development.



MAMATALIEV AVAZBEK - Associate Professor, Ph.D. - Heads the department from 2014 to the present.

He published about 40 scientific articles, more than 60 theses, 2 study guides, about 50 study guides and 8 proposals for rationalization, which were published and implemented.
