


## Department of Psychiatry and Addiction

In 1955, by the decision of the Government of Uzbekistan, a medical institute was opened in Andijan and construction of various facilities began.



The Department of Psychiatry was established in August 1959 on the basis of the Department of Neurology of the regional hospital. At the very beginning, due to the lack of personnel, psychiatrists from Samarkand and Tashkent were invited.

H. A. Alimov, K. A. Mammadov, A. A. Askerov, R., S. Tursunova and others were among the first to act in the region. In 1961, the head of the department was appointed Doctor of Medical Sciences Alimov Khudiyar Alimovich. In 1965, he was appointed head of the Department of Psychiatry at the Tashkent State Medical Institute. Mammadov Kuli Alievich, one of the first assistants of the department, Candidate of Medical Sciences (1963-1967), Askerov Akbar Askarovich (1963-1969), Zohidov Javad Abdullayevich (1963-1964). During the same years, the following assistants worked: Candidate of Medical Sciences Nikolai Iosifovich (1964-1968), Karimov Fazi Karimovich (1959-1965), Kakharova Regina Abdurakhmonovna (1961-1973). Since 1965, Associate Professor R. S. Tursunova headed the department and worked in this position until 1983. Under his leadership during this period, the following employees worked: Sadygov Igor Denisovich (1965-1981), Khodhibekova Klara Khodoikulovna (1968-1995), Matkarimov Yakub Matkarimovich (1969-1995), Zorkina Valentina Nikolaevna (1968-1991), Shamsiboeva Muazam Mamadalievna (1982-1985).

In 1975, a graduate of the Institute, M. L. Agranovsky, came to work. In 1987, he was elected head of the Department of Psychiatry, Narcology and Medical Psychology. In 1982, he defended his PhD thesis on the topic "Social and labor prognosis of severe periodic schizophrenia (Comparative clinical and epidemiological study)" before the deadline. In 1992, he defended his doctoral dissertation on the topic "The ratio of endogenous and exogenous factors in the risk of developing schizophrenia attacks (clinical and epidemiological study)" and in the

same year, M. L. Agranovsky was awarded the academic title of professor. Professor M. L. Agranovsky has published more than 1,200 scientific summaries, 127 scientific and methodological recommendations, 12 textbooks and 6 monographs. Under the scientific supervision of Professor M. L. Agranovsky, a total of 14 candidates of medical sciences and 2 doctors of medical Sciences were defended.

Research work at the department is carried out in several areas:

Epidemiology of endogenous psychoses, early diagnosis of mental disorders in young children and adolescents, the clinic of alcoholism and drug addiction, treatment and prevention, the impact of psychotherapy in the complex treatment of patients in emergency care, psychopathology of suicides and emergency care for them, the clinic and prognosis of familial endogenous depression. The obtained data are published annually as scientific articles, theses in central, local and foreign publications of our republic.

Along with carrying out educational and methodological, medical and consultative, spiritual and educational work, the staff of the department pays great attention to the training of research pedagogical personnel. Of the employees working at the department, one Doctor of Medical Sciences, professor, one Candidate of Medical Sciences, associate professor, 4 senior teachers, 8 assistants.

Over the past 5 years, the staff of the department has published 1110 scientific articles and theses, 186 teaching aids, 11 textbooks, 235 implementation acts have been put into practice. M. L. Agranovsky has published 6 monographs, defended 3 PhD theses. Currently, 5 PhD theses are being prepared for defense.

Along with the deep knowledge of students, the staff of the department conducts spiritual and educational, medical and advisory, research work, investing all their knowledge, strength and energy in the implementation of the national program "reforming medicine", "training", actively participates in the life of the institute and the hospital.

The head of the department, Professor M. L. Agranovsky annually conducts scientific and practical conferences on the topic of the relevance of the problem of drug addiction between students and young scientists.

For the next 10 years, every year in the first decade of June, on the day of "spirituality and enlightenment", the staff of the department, headed by the head of the department, Professor Mark Lazarevich Agranovsky, holds a large scientific conference on this problem, aimed at combating drug addiction, which is currently a problem all over the world and takes the lives of many of our young people.

Together with the staff of the department and the residents of the AOPND, the staff of the Department of Psychiatry under the leadership of Professor M. L. Agranovsky actively participate in the bypass and medical consultation of inpatient patients, examination of outpatient patients.
