In 1958, the Urology Department was opened at the N 1 City Hospital to provide urological care to patients and to train students as a base of AGMI. In 1963, K. Umarov was appointed head of the urology course. In 1964, Akhmedzhayev W.H. was appointed head of the urology course at optional surgery.

If at first the urologists had 15 beds, then it expanded by 30 beds. Operations on the upper and lower urinary tract and genitals were performed in the wards. Along with adults, operations were carried out in children. Advisory urological assistance was provided not only in the city of Andijan and the regions, but also throughout the Ferghana Valley.

In 1978, U.A. Eeshonghuzhayev was chosen as the head of the urology course. In April 1973, the urology course was transferred as a training base to the clinic of the Andijan State Medical Institute. The Urology Department has been expanded by 60 beds to provide urological assistance throughout the Ferghana Valley.

Since 2000, the Department of Urology is headed by Dr. Dr. A.K. Shadmanov. On the initiative of A.K. Shadmanov in 2005, a clinical residency base was opened in urology, and in 2007 a master's school and a school of professor A.K. Shadmanov were established. At the moment, the course of urology trained professional urologists who provide specialized assistance in the Ferghana Valley. His students work in all areas of the Republic of Uzbekistan, along with research work by Professor A.K. Shadmanov, who paid special attention to the development of the educational process. Students participating in the "Urology" group occupied honorary places in the republican Olympiads.

The Department of Urology, the Endourology Department, is of scientific importance and provides practical assistance in the Ferghana Valley. To date, all endoscopic operations are performed here.

Today, the department includes "Surgery, urology anesthesiology with resuscitation." The department is based in the department of urology of the AGMI clinic and provides planned and emergency assistance to the population. The department employs 1 professor (Shadmanov A.K.), 1 assistant professor (dr. M.M. Rustamov), assistants of DR. D.I. Sodikova, R.A. Boboyev, M.A. Shodmanov, O.A. Hamraev, B. A Ergashev. Three employees, as well as 31 masters and residents, are working at the department.

Professor Alisher Kayumovich Shadmanov A.K. Shadmanov, a professor who heads the course of urology, was born in 1962 in Tashkent. In 1979-1985. graduated from the Faculty of Medicine of AGMI. A.K. Shadmanov started his work in the department of urology as a resident physician in 1986, in 1990 he sewed up his Ph.D., in 2002 - a doctoral thesis. A.K. Shadmanov worked as an assistant, assistant professor and head of the course of urology, dean of the pediatric faculty of AGMI, provost for culture, vice-chancellor for the educational part of Andijan City Health, since 2010 the rector of AGMI, and since 2015 the deputy "Oliy Mazhlis" of the Republic of Uzbekistan.

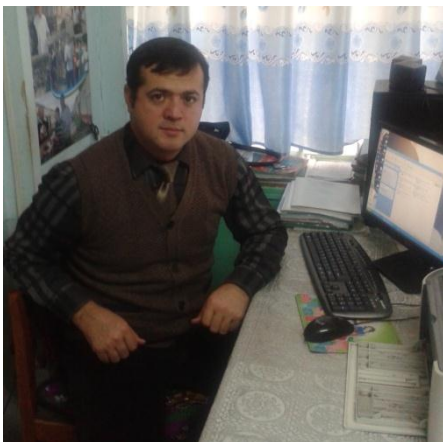
